Open Streets: Due to a lack of time and funds, Open Streets will be in 2016. Tara will update the membership on funding opportunities for this effort. The Steering Committee- which anyone is welcome to join is meeting July 19 at 3pm at Neutral Design on Gregory in Urbana (Campus). There are 2 grants that we are looking at People for Bikes, due July 31 and another is from the Bike Walk Alliance, it has a rolling due date.

Play Rx Update: Throughout the summer, HCC (including CUPHD, U of I, and Champaign Park District) is working to evaluate a program to treat obese youth with Play prescriptions. Over 50 kids have been enrolled in the pilot. There have been a few issues with transportation, bus tokens are being investigated.

Grant Updates: APA/APHA- There is an opportunity and some interest to apply for The American Planning Association's Plan4Health funding. The Letter of Intent is due July 1. Board Members did not want to invest the time because the APA did not give much constructive criticism on our first proposal, and they suggested they would likely fund projects elsewhere as 2 of the 18 projects they are currently funding are in Illinois (two in IN, and one in St. Louis). No one volunteered to pursue the opportunity. If anyone is interested in applying, email Nikki. She can forward the materials from the first application.

CUPHD will not receive the Coordinated School Health grant this year. This funding provided the opportunity to work on many issues around school wellness, like Safe Routes to School, Ped Plans, bike rodeos and CATCH.

CUPHD is a site for summer food: breakfast, lunch, and snack. USD 116 is offering summer food at Wiley, Leal, and King.

USD 116 will be voting to support Community Eligibility for School Lunch and Breakfast Program. Every student in USD 116 will be eligible for free lunch and breakfast.

The Extension Office is always looking for places to bring SNAP Ed and FNEP to the community in an attempt to reach their target audience.

Urbana Park District is offering a program called Commit to Be Fit once each month where there will be presentation on a wellness topic. This month was hydration.
